The following are criteria for selecting the admissible candidates:

1. Be a Rwandan
2. Fulfil the university entry requirements (Having an Advanced Certificate of Education with two principal passes and minimum score of 20/60 in the following subjects: PCM, MPG, MPC, PEM, MEG, MEC, MCB, MPB, Industrial Electricity, Hydropower Energy, Electricity, Electro mechanical, The TVET in Construction/Masonry and TTC in Sciences with Mathematics options and other related disciplines). Those who studied the secondary school abroad will present certificate of equivalence.
3. Be a girl between 18 – 25 years of age (except for persons with disabilities, where the age limit is extended to 30 years)
4. Have graduated from secondary school by the academic year 2021 – 2022 and before
5. Accepted applications are only for first year students
6. Girls with any type of vulnerability are encouraged (Disability, teen and single mothers, etc)

The application file as one document must comprise:

1. A copy of the certificate of secondary School as mentioned above;
2. A copy of National ID
3. One Coloured passport photo
4. For persons with disability, any proof is necessary
